

Wyoming Wheat Growers Annual Meeting
January 7, 2014
Albin, Wyoming

Doors opened at 8:00 a.m. for the exhibitors to set up and for registration. Coffee and donuts were sponsored by First State Bank. President Ken Tremain called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with some opening comments. At 9:15 Keith Kennedy gave a talk on the Wheat Marketing Commission. 9:30 was the Exhibitor Lightning Round. At 9:45 Gordon Stoner, Secretary/ Treasurer of the National Association of Wheat Growers, talked about using peas, beans and lentils in crop rotations. At 10:45 Frank Pearis, from CSU, talked about bugs, pests, sawfly, and creepers in wheat. At 11:30 the members in attendance voted on the following resolutions:

Resolution 1: With Multiple Peril Crop Insurance being of most importance to production agriculture we request that RMA and all insurance companies use a standardize identical insurance policy form that includes a complete legend for all abbreviations on that policy form so that it is as customer friendly as possible. Theron Anderson made the motion to accept the resolution. Casey Madsen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Resolution 2: We request a change in the time frame for renewal of DOT Medical Certificates from 2 yrs to 24 calendar months by the Department of Transportation. Theron Anderson made the motion to accept the resolution. Casey Madsen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Resolution 3: Keith Kennedy made the motion to accept HB23. This is to clean up some language and to help protect land owners from trespassers. Theron Anderson made the motion to accept the resolution. Ty Anderson seconded the motion. Motion passed.
