Procedure for the Wyoming Wheat Growers/Wheat Commission Scholarship:

The applicant must complete the application in full, **including a resume and a current transcript.** Your application must be submitted to either address in the application form **BEFORE** the deadline. The deadline for this application is May 1, 2019. Any application received after the deadline will not be eligible.

Disbursement of Funds: The winning applicant(s) will be notified by May 1 of each year. Actual monies will be disbursed as follows: Winning applicant(s) will be paid for the first half of their scholarship by August 15 of each year. **To receive the second half of your scholarship** you must submit a copy of a receipt and transcript, sufficient to prove enrollment for your second semester. After verification by our review committee, the second half of your scholarship will be dispersed after January 1.
